Fire Evacuation

IF a **FIRE** occurs, 4 floors of the building's occupants move away from the danger area:

- The FIRE floor
- One floor above fire floor
- and the two floors below fire floor will evacuate downward.

Where to go:

FLOORS 18 - 8:

Relocate down 4 floors and reenter the building on an unaffected floor.

Those receiving evacuees from the upper building will hear an announcement and open stairwell doors for evacuees.

FLOORS 7 AND BELOW:

Totally evacuate the building to the Safe Refuge Area – the Surface Parking Lot behind the building.

Earthquake Procedures

1. "DUCK, COVER, AND HOLD":

• Get under a table or desk to protect yourself from flying objects.

Street

· Stay away from windows.

Basement

- DO NOT stand in doorways.
- 2. Move toward the center "core" of the building when it is safe to do so.
- 3. Check your immediate work area for injured persons, fire, flooding, or electrical hazards.
- 4. REMAIN ON YOUR FLOOR unless:
- · Instructed to leave, or
- You are in imminent danger.
- During an earthquake, you are generally SAFER INSIDE the building than you are outside.
- 5. Follow the instructions of your Floor Warden or company management.
- **6. DO NOT USE ELEVATORS!** During an earthquake, elevators will automatically descend to the next floor and open their doors. They will then go out of service.
- 7. Refrain from using telephones, unless reporting emergencies. Use a battery-powered radio to obtain news information.
